

crochet pattern
maki

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You will find it is very easy to follow even for beginners.



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For this pattern you will need:

- Cotton yarn
(I used „Unitas Mirabela“, weight: Sport/5 ply, 155 yards (142 meters) in 50 grams (1.76 ounces))
but you can use any other yarn similar to this one here is also the link to Ravelry about that yarn

- 4 mm crochet hook
- needle with blunt tip

You will use a double strand of yarn for this pattern.

That means you will hold two strands together to create one strand while crocheting.

Stitches used:

- **ch** – chain
- **sc** - single crochet
- **hdc** – half double crochet
- **dc** - double crochet
- **slst** – slip stitch

This pattern is written in U.S. crochet terms.

**You can not copy, resell or distribute my pattern in any way.
However, feel free to sell finished items made by using this pattern.**

LET'S START!!!

TODDLER

Row 1: Ch 3, 12 dc in 3rd chain from the hook, slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 2: Ch 2, 2 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 2 dc in every dc around, slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 3: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 2 dc in next stitch, *1 dc in next, 2 dc in next (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 4: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 1 dc in next, 2 dc in next stitch, *1 dc in next 2 stitches, 2 dc in next (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 5: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 1 dc in next 2 stitches, 2 dc in next stitch, *1 dc in next 3 stitches, 2 dc in next (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 6: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 1 dc in next 3 stitches, 2 dc in next stitch, *1 dc in next 4 stitches, 2 dc in next (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

At this point the crown circle diameter for this size should be about 15 cm/6 in. (Pic 1)

Row 7 and 8: Ch2, 1 dc in every stitch around, slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Now you'll work in round.

Ch 4, skip dc that you made slst in, dc in next, (I recommend that at this point you tie a piece of contrasting yarn to a ch 4 so you'll know where your round begin like it is shown on the **Pic 2**)



*ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next (repeat from * around)

When you come to the chain 4 continue to work ch 1, dc in ch 4 space,

*ch1, dc in ch 1 space (repeat from * until you have worked 5 rounds - **Pic 3**).



This is the length of the hat and for this size it should be about 15 cm/6 in. (Pic 3)

Slst in next dc, ch 1, *sc in ch 1 space, sc in dc (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st sc from beginning.

Now let's make a brim! ☺

Attach second color

Row 1: 2 hdc in every sc from previous row, slst in 1st hdc from beginning.

Rows 2 – 5: Ch 1, 1 hdc in every hdc from previous row, slst in 1st hdc from beginning. Fasten off.



On **Pic 5** is **Child size** hat so you don't get confused if you are counting rows ☺

CHILD

Row 1: Ch 3, 12 dc in 3rd chain from the hook, slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 2: Ch 2, 2 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 2 dc in every dc around, slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 3: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 2 dc in next stitch, *1 dc in next, 2 dc in next (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 4: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 1 dc in next, 2 dc in next stitch, *1 dc in next 2 stitches, 2 dc in next (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 5: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 1 dc in next 2 stitches, 2 dc in next stitch, *1 dc in next 3 stitches, 2 dc in next (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 6: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 1 dc in next 3 stitches, 2 dc in next stitch, *1 dc in next 4 stitches, 2 dc in next (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 7: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 1 dc in next 4 stitches, 2 dc in next stitch, *1 dc in next 5 stitches, 2 dc in next (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

At this point the crown circle diameter for this size should be about 16.5 cm/6.5 in. (Pic 1)

Row 8 and 9: Ch2, 1 dc in every stitch around, slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Now you'll work in round.

Ch 4, skip dc that you made slst in, dc in next, (I recommend that at this point you tie a piece of contrasting yarn to a ch 4 so you'll know where your round begin like it is shown on the **Pic 2**)

*ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next (repeat from * around)

When you come to the chain 4 continue to work ch 1, dc in ch 4 space,

*ch1, dc in ch 1 space (repeat from * until you have worked 6 rounds - **Pic 3**).

This is the length of the hat and for this size it should be about 16.5 – 17 cm/6.5 - 6.7 in. (Pic 3)

Slst in next dc, ch 1, *sc in ch 1 space, sc in dc (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st sc from beginning.

Now let's make a brim! 😊

Attach second color (**Pic 4**)

Row 1: 2 hdc in every sc from previous row, slst in 1st hdc from beginning.

Rows 2 – 6: Ch 1, 1 hdc in every hdc from previous row, slst in 1st hdc from beginning. Fasten off.

ADULT

Row 1: Ch 3, 12 dc in 3rd chain from the hook, slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 2: Ch 2, 2 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 2 dc in every dc around, slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 3: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 2 dc in next stitch, *1 dc in next, 2 dc in next (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 4: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 1 dc in next, 2 dc in next stitch, *1 dc in next 2 stitches, 2 dc in next (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 5: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 1 dc in next 2 stitches, 2 dc in next stitch, *1 dc in next 3 stitches, 2 dc in next (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 6: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 1 dc in next 3 stitches, 2 dc in next stitch, *1 dc in next 4 stitches, 2 dc in next (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 7: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 1 dc in next 4 stitches, 2 dc in next stitch, *1 dc in next 5 stitches, 2 dc in next (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Row 8: Ch 2, 1 dc in the same dc that you made slst, 1 dc in next 5 stitches, 2 dc in next stitch, *1 dc in next 6 stitches, 2 dc in next (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

At this point the crown circle diameter for this size should be about 18 cm/7 in. (Pic 1)

Row 9 and 10: Ch2, 1 dc in every stitch around, slst in the 1st dc from beginning.

Now you'll work in round.

Ch 4, skip dc that you made slst in, dc in next, (I recommend that at this point you tie a piece of contrasting yarn to a ch 4 so you'll know where your round begin like it is shown on the **Pic 2**)

*ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next (repeat from * around)

When you come to the chain 4 continue to work ch 1, dc in ch 4 space,

*ch1, dc in ch 1 space (repeat from * until you have worked 7 rounds - **Pic 3**).

This is the length of the hat and for this size it should be about 18 – 19 cm/7 – 7.5 in. (Pic 3)

Slst in next dc, ch 1, *sc in ch 1 space, sc in dc (repeat from * around), slst in the 1st sc from beginning.

Now let's make a brim! 😊

Attach second color (**Pic 4**)

Row 1: 2 hdc in every sc from previous row, slst in 1st hdc from beginning.

Rows 2 – 7: Ch 1, 1 hdc in every hdc from previous row, slst in 1st hdc from beginning. Fasten off.

Flower and leaf

Leaf

Start with chain 4, slst in first chain to join in a ring.

Round 1:

*ch 4, 2 sc in 2nd chain from hook, sc next 2 ch, sc in foundation ring, repeat from * 4 times, do not join.

Round 2:

*sc in next 2 st, 2 dc in next st, 2 dc-1 trc-2 dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, sc in next 2 st, slst in next st, repeat from * 4 times. Fasten off.



Flower

Start with chain 4, slst in first chain to join in a ring.

Round 1:

*ch 3, sc into the ring, repeat from * 5 times.

Round 2:

*slst in 3ch space, ch 1, 3 dc in same 3ch space, ch 1, slst in same space, repeat from * 5 times.



To tie the leaf and flower to the hat make a lace of 100 ch.



Weave in all ends - And you're done.
